Progress on Welshmill Greenway

FROGS have got through the first stage of the application for £50,000 funding for the Welshmill Project, but there is much to be done before the final bid in September. River Friends and everyone are invited to have their say.

In a project of this size improvements must be done in phases, so if possible come along 21st May to Welshmill between 12 - 3pm to suggest what should take priority. Suggested uses of the site are:

- 1 a natural play space.
- 2 improvement of the existing play area
- 3 a cycle track
- 4 a woodland trail with attention paid to seating, flow and landscape planting.

Once we have your opinion FROGS will approach the Town Hall and others to see what further funding is available.

So come and enjoy yourself.

- 1 Make models/collages of the area out of clay or scrap.
- 2 There will be bike activity near the graffiti wall.
- 3 And you can give us your ideas about what Anthony Rogers might carve with the wood which will be on site. Should it be a feature or a seat?
